




Marriage of Women in Jannah

Question: It is mentioned that there will be Al-Hoorul 'Een for the men in paradise, so what will there be for the women?

The Shaykh Al-Fageeh Allaamah Ibn Uthaymeen said answered:

Allaah the Blessed and most High said about the bounties of paradise, "We have been your friends in the life of this world and are (so) in the Hereafter. Therein you shall have (all) that your inner-selves desire, and therein you shall have (all) for which you ask for. 'An entertainment from (Allaah), the Oft-Forgiving, Most Merciful." (Surah Fussilat 41: 31-32)

And the Blessed and the most High said,

"Trays of gold and cups will be passed round them, (there will be) therein all that the one's inner-selves could desire, all that the eyes could delight in, and you will abide therein forever." (Surah az-Zukhruf 43-71)

And it is known that marriage is from the greatest of things that the Nafs yearns for so surely it will take place in Paradise. So Allaah the Blessed and the most High will marry a woman in paradise to the individual who was her husband in this worldly life.

"Our Lord! And make them enter the 'Adn (Eden) Paradise (everlasting Gardens) which you have promised them, and to the righteous among their fathers, their wives, and their offspring! Verily, You are the All-Mighty, the All-Wise." (Surah Ghafir 40:8)

And if she did not marry in this worldly life then Allaah would marry her in paradise to one she would be delighted with.
