A2: It is permissible to do so due to the general saying of Allah (may He be Exalted): [﴿ And \(all\) the Most Beautiful Names belong to Allâh, so call on Him by them ﴾](#) This was also reported from the Prophet (peace be upon him). The Prophet (peace be upon him) pronounced Ruqyah (reciting Qur'an and saying supplications over the sick seeking healing) by saying: [﴿ O Lord of the people! Remove the difficulty and bring about healing as You are the Healer. There is no healing but Your Healing. ﴾](#)
