Eighth Question of Fatwa no. (4503):

Q8: Is it permissible to offer Salah (Prayer) while wearing amulets or not?

A8: Scholars have unanimously agreed on the prohibition of wearing amulets if they are not from the Qur'an, but there is disagreement about when they are from the Qur'an. Some have permitted wearing them, while others prohibit it. However, prohibition is the more preponderant opinion, as the majority of Hadiths support this and serves to quard against what

may lead to sins. Accordingly, it is impermissible and even more a priority not to wear them during Salah.
