The third question of Fatwa no. 6872

Q 3: What should a Muslim who has a non-Muslim sibling or child do?

A: Muslims should invite their non-Muslim relatives and others to Islam and explain to them the virtues of Islam and its beneficent laws and rulings. They should emphasize that Allah will not accept from any person a religion other than Islam (submission and resignation to Allah alone) on the Day of Resurrection. Perhaps Allah will guide them through them. In the Qur'an, Allah (Glorified and Exalted be He) says: (Invite (mankind, O Muhammad صلى الله عليه و سلم) to the Way of your Lord (i.e. Islâm) with wisdom (i.e. with the Divine Revelation and the Qur'ân) and fair preaching, and argue with them in a way that is better.)

Also, He (Glorified and Exalted be He) says: (And warn your tribe (O Muhammad صلى الله عليه of near kindred.) The Prophet (peace be upon him) said: (The one who guides to something good has a reward similar to that of its doer.) May Allah guide you and us to attain His Good Pleasure!

May Allah grant us success! May peace and blessings be upon our Prophet Muhammad, his family and Companions!
