## What is the ruling about Jamaah al-Tabligh?



Are they from the seventy-two sects going to the fire of hell? Or are they part of Ahl al-Sunnah wal-Jamāʿah but differing in certain issues with Ahl al-Sunnah?

A. Jamāʿah al-Tablīgh is a Jamāaʿah that is part of the Deobandī sect. The founder of Jamāʿah al-Tablīgh was a man by the name of Molvi Ilyās Deobandī, and the Deobandīs are a sect that are excluded from Ahl al-Sunnah wal–Jamāʿah.

The Deobandīs are a sect that are upon innovation and one of its branches is the Jamā'ah al-Tablīgh. Jamā'ah al-Tablīgh are the true followers of the Deobandī sect in belief and action and they are not part of Ahl al-Sunnah wal–Jamā'ah.
