

When should takbeer be said?
And ruling of congregational takbeer

The takbeer is prescribed during 'Eid ul fitr: from sunset (marking the end of Ramadhan) till the khutbah ends.

As for congregational takbeer then it's not allowed, it's a bida'h (newly invented matter in the religion) all of them saying it together in chorus this is bida'h, not permissible.

Doing Ghusl on the Day of 'Eid

'Abd-Allaah ibn 'Umar (may Allah be pleased with him) used to do ghusl on the day of al-Fitr before going out to the prayer-place in the morning. mubarak

Eating odd number of dates

Narrated Anas bin Malik:

Allah's Apostle never proceeded (for the prayer) on the Day of 'Eid ul fitr unless he had eaten some dates.

Anas also narrated:

The Prophet used to eat odd number of dates.
