A Shaykh's Humility and a Student's Manners: Al-Albaanee's Humility with 'Abdur-Razzaaq al-Badr

'Abdur-Razzaaq al-Badr: [These] two hours [we spent with you] feel like one!

Shaykh al-Albaanee (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ): Okay we can take a little break.

Shaykh al-Albaanee (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ): ... [you] as someone who is a strong student of knowledge inshaa Allaah ...

'Abdur-Razzaaq al-Badr: I ask Allaah to make me one ...

Shaykh al-Albaanee (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ): ... and who wants to gain understanding of his religion ...

'Abdur-Razzaaq al-Badr: may Allaah grant me success in that ...

Shaykh al-Albaanee (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ): ... that is my good fortune ...

'Abdur-Razzaaq al-Badr: No it is ours, O Shaykh.

Shaykh al-Albaanee (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ): May Allaah bless you.

'Abdur-Razzaaq al-Badr: May Allaah honour you.
