Concerning the merit of supplicating during last hour on Friday and the agreement of the Companions regarding that

“The Prophet (صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ)<sup>1</sup> said, ‘Friday is divided into twelve hours. Amongst them there is an hour in which a Muslim does not ask Allaah for anything but He gives it to him. So seek it in the last hour after the afternoon [‘Asr] prayer.’<sup>2</sup>

Shaykh al-Albaanee (رَحِمَهُ اللَّهُ)<sup>3</sup> said, ‘And the agreement of the Companions that it is the last hour on Friday has been authentically reported, so it is not allowed to oppose them.’<sup>4</sup>
