Mistake of prostrating before the Imaam

بسم الله الرحمن الرحيم

In the name of Allaah, the Most Merciful, the Bestower of Mercy

Shaykh al-Albaanee (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ) said: "The brother here - also reminded [us of] another calamity common amongst those who pray and which is in opposition to the Sunnah: Al-Baraa ibn 'Aazib, (رضى الله عنه)², said that when we would pray behind the Prophet had (صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ) we would not prostrate until we saw that the Prophet (صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ) placed his forehead on the ground.

Nowadays after saying, 'Sami'Allaahu liman hamidah, Rabbanaa wa lakal-Hamd,' the Imaam will barely have said, 'Allaahu Akbar,' except that the people [behind him] will have fallen down into prostration with him—this is a mistake.

He would say, 'Allaahu Akbar,' and when he was seen to have finished going into prostration and had placed his forehead on the ground, it was then that the row behind him would start ". (صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ) to go into prostration with him
