Shaykh al-Albaanee (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ) said, 'The hadeeth contains clear proof showing that it is haraam for a rich neighbour to leave his neighbours hungry, he must give them something they can repel their hunger with and similarly what they can cover themselves with if they were naked and likewise with other such necessities.'"
