
One Salafee trying to impose his opinion on another

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بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

Shaykh al-Albaanee (رَحْمَةُ اللَّهِ)¹ destroys the stance of one Salafee trying to impose his opinion on another

The Imaam (رَحْمَةُ اللَّهِ) said, “Your imposition on another to adopt your opinion whilst he is not convinced of it negates one of the principles of the Salafee da’wah—which is that judgement [Haakimiyyah] is for Allaah Alone, and I reminded him of the Most High’s Statement, ‘**They have taken their scholars and monks as lords besides Allaah,**’² thus it is enough for you that each one of you remains on his opinion—since neither one of you is convinced of the other’s—and that you should not declare him to be misguided, as he should not declare you to be misguided, and through that it is possible for you to continue cooperating with him in those principles of the da’wah and their subsidiary issues that you are both agreed upon.”³
