Shaykh Ibn Uthaymeen (رَحِمَهُ اللَّهُ)¹ said, "Good manners with Allaah is that you receive His Legislative Judgements with contentment and submission, that you have no discomfort towards them and that you are not fed up with them. So when Allaah (تعالى)² orders you to pray, to give zakaah, to fast and other such things, then you accept that with an open heart [lit. expanded breast]."³
