Question: What is possession? What are its symptoms? How could it be treated in a Shar'eh (Islaamically lawful) way?

Shaykh Abdul-Azeez ibn Baaz (رَحِمَهُ اللهُ)¹: The possession means the Jinn's control over man, as Allaah (Exalted be He) says: [**Those who eat Ribaa** (usury) **will not stand** (on the Day of Resurrection) **except like the standing of a person beaten by Shaytaan** (Satan) **leading him to insanity**].

It should be treated with the Noble Qur'aan, the Prophetic Du'aa' (supplications), advice and reminders, encouragement to do good and inspiring fear of doing evil. May Allaah grant us success.
