Question: What is possession? What are its symptoms? How could it be treated in a Shar'eh (Islaamically lawful) way?

Shaykh Abdul-Azeez ibn Baaz (رَحِمَهُ الله)¹: The possession means the Jinn's control over man, as Allaah (Exalted be He) says: [Those who eat Ribaa (usury) will not stand (on the Day of Resurrection) except like the standing of a person beaten by Shaytaan (Satan) leading him to insanity].

It should be treated with the Noble Qur'aan, the Prophetic Du'aa' (supplications), advice and reminders, encouragement to do good and inspiring fear of doing evil. May Allaah grant us success.
