

## Meaning of dhulm

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

With regards to the types of dhulm (oppression), Shaykh Muhammad ibn Saalih al 'Uthaymeen (رَحْمَةُ اللَّهِ)<sup>1</sup> states:

(The types of dhulm):

- 1) The most oppressive (form)of dhulm ; and it is shirk with regards to Allaah.
- 2) The dhulm done by a person against his own self so he does not give it its right; for example, that he fasts and does not break the fast and he stands and does not sleep.
- 3) The dhulm done by a person against someone else; for example, when he transgresses against a person through hitting (him) or killing (him) or taking (his) wealth or whatever resembles that.
