

Fatwa no. 326

Q: A husband disputed with his wife, and as a result he said to her, "If you are destined to get divorce, it will befall you." What is the consequence of that?

A: If the reality is as mentioned, that he said to his wife after quarreling with her, "If you are destined to get divorce, it will befall you" and said nothing else, this is not considered divorce; rather, it is a promise of divorce. If he divorces her after that promise, his divorce will count. If he does not, this promise will not affect his marital life.
